

44th Avenue W. Trail Bridge and Interurban Trail

Lynnwood, Washington



This project constructed a one-quarter mile paved trail and a trail bridge overpass adjacent to I-5 and over 44th Avenue West in Lynnwood.

Osborn Pacific Group was responsible for designing the trail alignment along the Snohomish County PUD transmission corridor and preparing construction documents for the trail, connections to the trail bridge, connections to the existing interurban trail, landscaping, and irrigation.

Osborn Pacific Group also prepared the mitigation design and construction documents for wetland impacts, and prepared the streetscape design along 44th Avenue W.

In addition, Osborn Pacific Group prepared all of the environmental documentation including the SEPA Checklist, NEPA ECS, Cultural Resource APE, and Biological Assessment, obtained the required permits, and co-led public workshops.

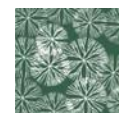
