

# EAST EVERETT PARK

Everett, Washington



The proposed regional Everett park is a 330-acre site located at the northern terminus of the Marshland Flood Control District canal at 6000 Lowell-Snohomish River Road in Everett, Washington.

Important human values are associated with the historical agricultural uses of the valley and the various recreational benefits linked with its open landscape, open vistas, presence of wildlife, and a place to get away from the activity of suburban and urban living.

Approximately 200 acres of city-owned land may

eventually become an exciting venue for mixed recreation uses. Multi-purpose sports fields, soccer fields, ball fields, nature preserves, picnicking, golfing, pea patch, and trails are among many proposed recreation facilities/opportunities in the park.

One side of the park site with wetlands and an agricultural-zoned parcel is thought to be most appropriate for passive uses. Habitat enhancement is the primary focus, with some space devoted to the development of multi-use turf fields and an amphitheater for special event use.
