## TERMINAL 108

Seattle, Washington



Terminal 108 features a waterfront public access area and provides parking, a car-top boat launch ramp and pedestrian amenities. The landscape planting consists of native riparian vegetation in a natural setting for nesting waterfowl. Views of the Duwamish River and landscape buffers to screen the adjoining industrial yards were also critical design issues. The design process included extensive citizen involvement.

A subsequent design and construction phase included development of a mini-park and waterfront public access.
